Case Studies from Manufacturers/implementing agencies/consultants:

Case studies aligned to the scope of the conference. Submit an abstract of upto 500 words to the Curator. Once reviewed and accepted, the final submission should contain a power point presentation (in pdf format, not more than 5mb) covering the Aim, Approach, Description, Photographs, Schematics, Results and Conclusions.

Proposal for Panel Discussions: Panel discussions on topics (but not limited to)-

- a) Impact of various roofing strategies to mitigate the UHI such as white and green roofs;
- b) Impact of UHI on the economy; & c) Policies to reduce UHI

The 600 words proposal should contain the title, need for a panel discussion, topics to be discussed. Brief profile of proposed panelist is to be submitted separately. Normally, the structure of four (4) members and a moderator would be preferred. Proposals are to be submitted directly to the respective Curator.
